

About the Jockey Club MEL Institute Project (Phase Two)

Funded by The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, CUHK's Department of Social Work has been implementing a three-year programme, the Jockey Club MEL Institute Project (Phase Two), since 2022. This initiative aims to enhance the knowledge and experience of Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) among local NGOs and social enterprises. The Project offers a 14-session training course led by both local and international experts, focusing on four key areas: Service Development and Monitoring, Infrastructure and Talent Development for MEL Organisational Practice, Outcome and Impact Communication, and Programme Evaluation and Impact Assessment. Participants also engage in a four-month mentored practicum, where they apply their learning to real-world projects under the guidance of experienced mentors. Additionally, the project features an Online Knowledge Hub, which serves as a vital resource for enhancing participants' learning experiences.
